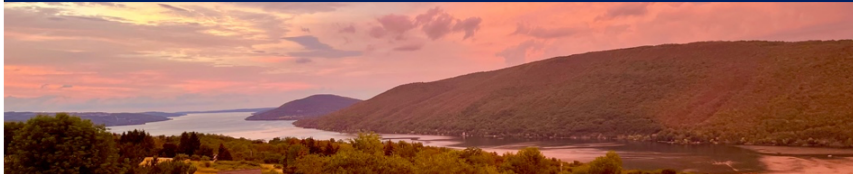

Letter from the Supervisor

Hello and Happy Fourth!

We had a great launch of the 250th (1776–2026) Celebration at the **Freedom Festival** sponsored by South Bristol, Bristol, and the Town of Canandaigua. New York State Senator Pam Helming and Assemblywoman Andrea Bailey joined our consummate host, Bristol Supervisor Laura Abplanalp, Canandaigua Board Member Scott Hall, and me to kick off the Flag Day extravaganza at Levi Corser Park. I was also honored to be invited to the solemn Flag Day service held annually at the Elks Lodge (Elks Club Post 256) where I met the 104 year young WWII Veteran Gene Gerrard.



South Bristol has also kicked into high gear for the fourth by **sprucing up the Scenic Overlook**. Working in the rain with volunteers and the Parks & Rec committee may have been my happiest day as Supervisor. **Huge shout out and gratitude** for the expertise and hard work of those who made this happen: **Matthew Spear, Beth Fitch, and Jeff Liebentritt**.

Big thanks also to Councilmember Chris Abraham, Town Board liaison for Parks & Rec, and **Highway Superintendent Jim Wight**, for their work on the project. Parks & Rec is planning more upgrades of the Overlook in partnership with our Highway Department and the Finger Lakes Land Trust—stay tuned for more info!

I hope you heard about the **revitalization of our playground** on the **radio** or read about it in the ***Finger Lakes Daily News, Finger Lakes Times, or Daily Messenger***, all of which carried our story! Again, thank you to Councilmember Abraham and Superintendent Wight. A formal dedication ceremony will be held on **August 8**, the birthday of the South Bristol's founder, Gamaliel Wilder.

An ongoing effort by our **Community Engagement Committee** to dynamically engage in open communication with our South Bristol community brought **Ontario County Director of Sustainability Carla Jordan** to speak about the impact of the landfill closure on South Bristol at the last town board meeting. A Community Engagement panel discussion on the landfill closure, **moderated by Councilmember Jamie Hall**, will be held at the town hall on **July 20th**. More information about the event is in the mail—paid for by a grant awarded to South Bristol by the Ontario County Sustainability and Solid Waste Department.

As part of our **commitment to fiscal responsibility**, I have been able to **secure 98% of the town's funds in interest-bearing accounts—an increase of 28%**. In addition, our audit has been completed. Thank you to all the department heads who diligently supported the efforts of the audit team. A report is forthcoming, as are resolutions vetted by the finance committee and our town lawyer on our **policies for fund balance, procurement, and ethics**.

In addition, we were fortunate to have an intern, recent high school graduate Charlie Dickinson, do **research on state grants that align with our comprehensive plan**, and I will be working with our finance committee's grants working group on applications. These state grants drop annually each June and must be completed by July 31st.

From parks to panel discussions to fiscal responsibility, I want to take a moment to acknowledge the huge effort involved, and **extend our thanks for the dedication of these citizen-led committees**.


Finally, I am thrilled to invite you to our **Town Board meeting on July 13th** where New York State Senator **Pam Helming** will present a **New York State Senate Commendation**, the highest honor awarded in the state, to South Bristol resident **Wende Logan Young**, an internationally recognized pioneer in breast cancer diagnosis and care. She will also present **Senate Citations of Service** to acknowledge the significant contributions to the community of **John French and Sherry Brahm French** for their work as founders of Naples Open Cupboard, **Don DeClerck** for his commitment to conservation and his decades of service to the J. Warren Cutler Scout Reservation (Cutler Camp), and to **John Holtz and the Bristol Hills Historical Society** for the publication of *Mystery and History: Legends and Lore of the Bristol Hills*, featured in an award-winning documentary. Both Senator Pam Helming and Assemblywoman Andrea Bailey will be at our Town Board meeting where we will find out more about the State of the State now that the state budget has been completed.
